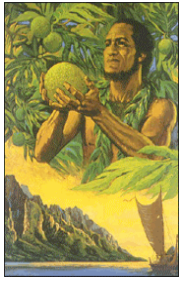

THE HAWAI'I ISLAND LEADERSHIP SERIES ULUMAU

The Intention

To seek out outstanding individuals each year who have demonstrated a sincere interest in the welfare of Hawai'i Island and through their participation in the program to expand the ranks of community leadership by providing a broad range of leaders with the knowledge and incentive to confront the needs of our community.

The Series

The class year begins in September with an orientation, followed by a two-day opening retreat. From October through the following May, the classes meet once per month, with full-day sessions around Hawai'i Island, to provide working hands-on knowledge of pertinent issues facing the community. The sessions conclude with a two-day retreat in June. In addition to classes, each member will be required to participate in a small group project addressing a particular issue or assisting an organization in need.

The series informs, motivates and raises the awareness of community issues and sense of community trusteeship through seminars, tours, reading and interaction with experts, leaders and decision-makers. Speakers and panelists, experts in their fields, provide background as well as predictions for the future of the community. Subjects explored in depth include: Hawaiian values and history, public and private education, government, healthcare services, the judicial system, agriculture and natural resources, the sciences, tourism, development, quality of life and future plans for Hawai'i Island.

Eligibility and Application for the Series

Admission to the series is via a written application can be obtained at www.ulumau.org.

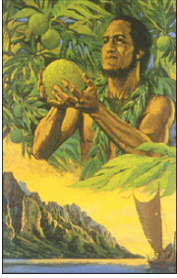
Applications must be delivered to the Friends of the Future office **NO LATER THAN JUNE 30, 2007**. Notification of acceptance will be given by July 16, 2007.

From the applicants, an anonymous committee of community leaders selects the class members. The committee endeavors to make each class reflective of the community in terms of gender, race and profession, as well as an even ratio of public and private sector representation.

The typical applicant will have lived in Hawai'i for three or more years and has both a demonstrated interest in community issues and a record of participation in voluntary community activities. Ideally, applicants occupy professional positions reflecting significant achievement relative to age and experience.

The cost for the series is \$1,100 per accepted participant. This includes the cost for meals at monthly sessions, meals and accommodations at both retreats, and speaker

and facilitator fees. Upon notification of acceptance, the \$1,100 series fee is due and payable.



THE HAWAI'I ISLAND LEADERSHIP SERIES ULUMAU

Selection Criteria

The most important factor in the Hawai'i Island Leadership Series selection process is the identification of those individuals most apt to use their leadership for the long-term benefit of the community. The program selects individuals with a desire for a deeper understanding of Hawai'i Island and with a sincere commitment to serve in the community. Basic factors that are considered in the selection process of candidates are:

1. Have demonstrated an interest in and a commitment to volunteerism.
2. Have demonstrated an understanding of and interest in the community.
3. Exhibit many qualities associated with leadership.
4. Have the time and energy to participate and commit to the series. (Orientation, two retreats, and 80% of monthly sessions are mandatory.)
5. Able to increase volunteer activity during the program year.
6. Have sponsor and/or necessary references.
7. Has been a resident of Hawai'i for a minimum of three years.
8. Have executive/management responsibilities in a professional capacity.

All participants are selected to represent the diversity of our community.
